Highlights of April 2018 Vestry Meeting

Church App Development—CCA is moving toward a new Church app called “eChurch,” which may take a month or two to get rolling.

Digital Organ—The organ has been ordered with surround sound and cushion. The custom cherry stained cabinet matches our mesquite altar furniture and is expected in 16-20 weeks to install.

A/V System Improvements—System is being reviewed. Equipment may be replaced, added to or repaired, but improvement is expected.

Master Plan / Replacing Portables with Spacious Storage—The plans are under way. Soon the Congregation will hear the results.

Street Sign Repair—We will soon have a date for installation.

Young Priest Search—Fr Lance Lormand is coming in with his wife and children for the weekend from Tucson. Sunday lunch after church is just a look-see, not an invitation to join us just yet.

Odessa Property Wrap-Up—\$150,000 sales price netted \$131,476 after \$18,000 closing costs, realtor fees, taxes, etc. \$1,426.26 year-to-date taxes refunded. \$9,952 in Odessa restricted account will offset that tax.

Forty Days of Prayer Small Group Participation Update—Fr Jonathan reported there are 10 small groups, with 98 participants, which is about half of our average Sunday attendance participating. Kudos to Fr Jonathan for his efforts. (Cont. next column)
